

STRANGERS... DON'T LET THEM INTO THE FLATS

We understand you may want to be polite and courteous but please don't let strangers into your blocks. Strangers who turn up unannounced could be bogus callers, that will try to gain your trust and trick you out of money. Not everyone is who they appear to be. We want you to help protect you and your neighbours.

If you are in doubt of the identity of any caller, for example, a contractor, don't hesitate to contact Clydebank Housing Association (CHA). If the caller is legitimate, they won't mind waiting. All CHA staff carry and display photographic ID.

Let's work together to keep your blocks safe and secure.

BOGUS CALLER ADVICE

- Bogus callers can be male or female, young or old. Do not be fooled by a callers appearance or manner
- If you do not wish to be disturbed put your intercom on privacy
- If you do not know the person who is calling and you are not expecting them, do not let them in
- Never let people try to persuade you to let them enter your home
- Never let anyone into your home to make a phone call
- Never give money to strangers who arrive at your door
- If a person refuses to leave your door, phone 999 and ask for the Police
