
Could you help run our Association?

Introduction

Clydebank Housing Association is a large social landlord operating for 40 years in Clydebank in 2024! Exciting times!

You would play a key role in helping Clydebank Housing Association shape its future direction and decision making about our community. We have a strong track record and reputation in the community and intend to build on this with our plans for the future. However, none of this can be achieved without the commitment of an experienced voluntary Management Committee.

A few spaces on our Management Committee are currently vacant. We hope that you will consider applying!



Our Role as Factor & our Wider Role

As well as managing and maintaining our homes, we are also factor to 600 properties.

We also take a 'wider role' in our community to improve the social, economic and environmental circumstances facing our community.

As part of our wider role, we own and manage Centre81, our thriving community and regeneration centre which opened in 2008. The Centre is home to Gym81, Café81, a community garden, raised beds area and has an outdoor multi use games area (MUGA).

We also have a subsidiary, CHA Power Ltd, which provides energy efficient and affordable heat and hot water to over 370 multi storey flats and the local church.

What does a Committee Member do?

Our current Management Committee is made up of tenants and local community representatives of all ages and backgrounds.

It would be great to hear from anyone who would like to get involved especially young people and those from ethnic minority backgrounds (who are currently underrepresented on our Management Committee).

The Management Committee is made up of up to 15 Members and includes a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer.

These positions are filled annually after every AGM. The Management Committee makes all the important decisions about what we should be doing and how we should be doing it. Staff are employed by the Management Committee to act on these decisions and to carry out our day to day work.

All you need is to:

Have an interest in housing and the well being of the local community in which we operate Attend around 10 meetings per year, normally held on Tuesdays between 6pm and 7.30pm. You can attend in person or online. Read and prepare for meetings in advance Be willing to attend training events Respect the confidentiality of the business of the Association Use your knowledge and skills to contribute to the work of the Association Work hand in hand with the staff Follow the agreed policies and procedures of the Association Adhere to our Code of Conduct for Committee Members Be older than 18 years old Not be an employee of the Association or a close relative of an employee
